OVERVIEW:

- Unique design, easy to mount and full of features; offers any bike maximum luggage capacity
- Universal quick-detach mounting system quickly secures bag to frame, passenger pegs, etc.; tunnel straddles most racks and seats for easy on/off mounting

- Wide top opening for easy packing
- Top carry handle and shoulder strap for easy toting off bike
- Constructed of UV-, water-, and weather-resistant 1200 denier Saddle Tuff[™] and leather-like vinyl panels; non-skid bottom is heat-resistant

- TS3200DE Cruiser and TS3200DE Tactical bags mount to your bike the same way, but each has different features that make it unique

IMPORTANT:

Please read these instructions completely before starting installation. All "NOTE," "CAUTION" and "WARNING" notations are serious safety issues and should be read carefully. Possible injury to riders or damage to the motorcycle and/or accessory may result if improperly installed.

NOTICE TO DEALERS:

These instructions contain important information for future reference and should be given to the customer.

🛕 WARNING:

READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS THOROUGHLY BEFORE INSTALLATION!

Because of the variety of motorcycle or ATV configurations, other accessories, and the features and intended use of this Saddlemen accessory bag, there could be many different mounting options. You are responsible for the proper installation of this luggage onto your motorcycle. Your attention to these installation instructions and recommendations will permit safe and proper use of this luggage. You must mount this bag properly and securely before riding your motorcycle. If you lack the ability to safely and properly install this bag, seek out a qualified motorcycle technician for assistance. During installation, support the motorcycle with a suitable stand or lift so it will not tip over and injure you, or damage the vehicle. Using or mounting this bag improperly could result in a loss of control of the motorcycle which could result in damage to your motorcycle or other personal property, the property of third parties, and/or personal injury to yourself or others, up to and including death.







A WARNING:

BE SURE TO THOROUGHLY READ AND CLOSELY FOLLOW THE MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS THAT ARE INCLUDED WITH THIS LUGGAGE:

- The tail bag must be securely fastened onto the luggage rack, seat, grab rails or similar solid part of the vehicle.
- For your safety, mount this bag securely so it will not shift or move while riding. Make sure it will not contact the controls or any other moving parts of your vehicle. The mounting straps must not contact the wheels, suspension or any other moving parts of the vehicle.
- If you do not understand the mounting instructions DO NOT mount the bag. Remove the straps you may have already installed on your vehicle. Do not use this bag if you have any doubts as to whether it is properly mounted to your vehicle.
- Before riding, secure your cargo inside the bag and completely close all lids or flaps. Thoroughly inspect your motorcycle luggage before every ride.
- Do not use the tail bag if its mounting straps have been modified, have deteriorated, loosened or are beginning to fail.
- Do not exceed 15 pounds of total weight of the combined weight of the tail bag and other cargo.
- When using this accessory, do not exceed your vehicle's Maximum Gross Vehicle Weight as listed in the manufacturer's owner's manual.
- Do not transport or store flammable or potentially explosive materials in your tail bag.
- If your bag is ever damaged, do not use it until it has been inspected by your local professional motorcycle dealer. Replace the bag or the straps immediately if they have damage that prevents the bag from being properly secured to your vehicle or from securely holding its contents.
- Continually check the security of this luggage at each stop as you ride. Hardware and straps on a motor vehicle can loosen during operation, so be sure to check these items frequently.

DO NOT ATTEMPT TO USE THIS LUGGAGE IF:

- You do not understand these installation and use instructions;
- You do not understand any part of the accessory mounting system;
- You have any doubts as to the security of the mounting system.

Remember: Motorcycling can be a dangerous activity. Installation of any accessory can increase your risk if it is not installed properly. You are responsible to install this accessory so it will not contact any portion of the drive train, suspension or steering, or if it will in any way interfere with the operation of your motorcycle.

To avoid injury, install while engine is cold.

CAUTION:

Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition before installation of any part of this product.

INSTALLATION:

See illustration to the right. Place the Tail Bag on your vehicle's passenger seat or luggage rack, connecting at least two of the supplied mounting straps (1) to the bag.


There are four female quick release buckles on the bag (2) that accept the male quick-release buckles (3) on the ends of the mounting straps. Be sure to attach each strap to a secure part of the motorcycle, such as a frame member, saddlebag support, luggage rack or non-flexible turn signal.

Tighten each strap and secure every loose end so that the strap cannot interfere with the operation of the vehicle.

IMPORTANT

For your safety, and the protection of your property and vehicle, it is essential that you secure your tail bag properly to your vehicle before riding. Use any combination of mounting and cinch-straps that will most securely hold your bag to the vehicle's luggage rack or seat.

After installing the bag, cut off or secure any excess security strap material so it will not interfere with the motorcycle's controls, suspension, wheels or other components. After cutting strap material, seal the cut edge of the strap with the flame from a cigarette lighter (use caution and a small amount of flame to not excessively burn the strap). Do not operate the motorcycle if the straps are still in place after removing the bag, as the straps could interfere with the safe operation of the vehicle.



If necessary, you can also attach the supplied mounting straps (equipped with snap-hooks on the end) to a solid part of the motorcycle, and connect them to the D-rings on the bag.

Once attached, make sure the bag is unable to move from side to side or forward and rearward. Test the bag for movement under moderate pressure, and reconnect or tighten the straps until the bag is securely attached to the bike.

After you've loaded the bag, tighten the cinch straps across the top of the bag. These straps not only help secure the cargo inside the bag, but can also be used to secure a jacket or other items to your tail bag.

You can use small padlocks (purchased separately) to secure two zipper fobs together, to deter accessing your tail bag. Keep one of the padlock's keys in a safe place in case you misplace the other key.

NOTE:

SHOULDER STRAP

To use the included Shoulder Strap, attach clip one end to the D-ring mounted above each side pocket. Repeat process on the opposite side. Adjust the strap length as needed.

CARE AND CLEANING

Your Saddlemen bag requires almost no maintenance other than periodic cleaning with mild soap and water and the application of a UV inhibitor to prevent color fading caused by UVA and UVB sun exposure. We recommend Ray Bloc Fabric Protector or similar which can be purchased online or at your local home improvement store

CAUTION:

- DO NOT connect any mounting straps or any additional securing straps to flexible or moving parts of the motorcycle (rubber mounted turn signals, swing arm, shocks, wheels etc.)
- You must tuck away, tie, or cut/shorten all loose mounting straps BEFORE you ride the motorcycle.
- Tighten each strap and secure each loose end so that the strap cannot interfere with the operation of the motorcycle.
- If the bag contacts your vehicle's painted surface, the paint finish could be scuffed or scratched. Saddlemen offers protective tape kit (p.n. 4320-0807) that can be placed over paint to protect the finish, if your desired mounting location causes the bag to contact painted surfaces.
- Failure to install this Tail Bag properly may allow portions of the bag or its mounting straps to come into contact with the motorcycle's moving parts or controls. It is vital that you verify that neither the Tail Bag nor any of its parts touch, or interfere with other motorcycle components while the steering and suspension moves through its entire range of motion.
- Make sure that the Tail Bag and its mounting straps or hardware cannot come into contact with the exhaust or any other component of the motorcycle, as the Tail Bag or other vehicle components may be damaged by contact.
- DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN THE MOUNTING STRAPS: Overtightening the mounting straps can cause the D-rings to separate from the bag. Use additional mounting straps rather than overtightening the straps.
- Check bag mounting strap tightness each time you stop.
- It is your responsibility to make sure the installation of this accessory does not create an unsafe or illegal condition. Check to be sure that all lights and safety reflectors are visible once your accessory bag is in place. If the bag blocks any side reflectors, place reflectors on the exterior sides of the bags (reflectors with self-adhesive backing are available from motorcycle or automobile supply stores).

Remember: Motorcycling can be a dangerous activity. Installation of any accessory can increase your risk if it is not installed properly. You are responsible to install this accessory so it will not contact any portion of the drivetrain, suspension or steering, or if it will in any way interfere with the operation of your motorcycle.

After 50 miles (80 kilometers), recheck the security of all mounting straps. Inspect the mounting periodically during normal maintenance checks thereafter. Inspect the bag and related hardware before, and during, each ride. A loose bag or hardware can interfere with the vehicle's operation and cause an unsafe riding condition.
