

# **USER GUIDE & INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

**DESCRIPTION:** Saddlemen Tool Pouches FITMENT: Universal

### **OVERVIEW:**

Saddlemen Tool Pouches are designed to be universal mount, all-purpose pouches for carrying tools or any small cargo.

### IMPORTANT:

READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS THOROUGHLY BEFORE INSTALLATION. All "NOTE," "CAUTION" and "WARNING" notations are serious safety issues and should be read carefully. Possible injury to riders or damage to the motorcycle and/or accessory may result if improperly installed.

### **NOTICE TO DEALERS:**

These instructions contain important information for future reference and should be given to the customer.

#### **CAUTION:**

- Because of the variety of motorcycle configurations, other accessories, and the features and intended use of this tool pouch, there could be many different mounting options. You are responsible for the proper installation of this accessory on your motorcycle. Your attention to these installation instructions and recommendations will permit safe and proper use of this tool pouch.
- This pouch is intended to mount on a motorcycle handlebar, fork, luggage rack, sissy bar or triple clamp. It must not touch or contact any moving components on your motorcycle, i.e., drivetrain or suspension, or any source of heat (engine or exhaust).
- Install the pouch securely so that it does not shift or move while riding. Make sure there are no loose mounting straps or hardware contacting the wheels, suspension or interfering with any moving parts of the motorcycle.
- If you do not understand these instructions DO NOT mount this tool pouch. Remove all straps or components you may have already installed on your motorcycle.
- Thoroughly inspect the mounting straps every ride. Do not use this pouch if the mounting system has been modified, deteriorated, loosened or is beginning to fail. Straps can loosen during operation, so be sure to check them frequently.
- Do not use this tool pouch if you have any doubts as to whether it is properly mounted to your motorcycle.
- Do not exceed 6 pounds of total weight in the tool pouch. Use caution when mounting it, that the weight does not affect your motorcycle's handling.
- When using this pouch, do not exceed your vehicle's Maximum Gross Vehicle Weight as listed on your motorcycle or in the manufacturer's owner's manual.
- If you lack the ability to safely and properly install this pouch, seek out a qualified motorcycle technician for assistance.
- During installation, support the motorcycle with a suitable stand or lift so it will not tip over and injure you, or damage the vehicle.
- Using or mounting this accessory improperly could result in a loss of control of the motorcycle which could result in damage to your motorcycle or other personal property, the property of third parties, and/or personal injury to yourself or others, up to and including death.

  DO NOT ATTEMPT TO USE THIS TOOL POUCH IF:
- You do not understand these installation and use instructions,
- You do not understand any part of the mounting system,
- You have any doubts as to the security of the mounting system.

## **CAUTION:**

Motorcycling can be a dangerous activity. Installation of any accessory can increase your risk if it is not installed properly. You are responsible to install this tool pouch so it will not contact any portion of the drive train, suspension or steering, or if it will in any way interfere with the operation of your motorcycle.

To avoid injury, install while engine is cold.


#### INSTALLATION:

- 1. Saddlemen tool bags are designed as a universal fit, using two straps to attach to handlebars, forks, back seat, luggage rack or sissybar.
- 2. Two nylon mounting straps are included, which are secured by D-rings. There are numerous options for mounting the bag to your bike, either vertically or horizontally to best suit your mounting location. Insert straps through tool pouch anchors, per the diagram below.
- 3. Secure the straps through the two D-rings and tighten until snug. Make sure both straps are tightened securely so bag does not move around while riding. When finished, you may choose to cut the excess strap length with scissors. Using caution, seal the strap end with a lighter.

DO NOT connect any straps to flexible or moving parts (rubber mounted turn signals, swingarm, shocks).

NOTE: You must tuck away or tie down all loose mounting straps BEFORE you ride the motorcycle. See warning information above.

NOTE: Recheck strap tightness each time you stop riding your vehicle after installing new accessories as its handling characteristics may have changed.



## IMPORTANT:

After 50 miles (80 kilometers), recheck the tightness of your tool pouch installation and any related hardware. Inspect the pouch and strap security before each ride. Loose accessories can interfere with the motorcycle's operation and cause an unsafe riding condition.

#### LIMITED WARRANTY POLICY
