

MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS

Suzuki C90 2005-2009 Solo and Passenger Seat

<u>Hardware:</u> Solo: Passenger:

Chrome stud bracketStock 8mm rear fender screw White nylon washer white nylon washer

Slotted nut

Stock 6mm Allen bolt x4

Tools needed: 6mm Allen wrench

5/8" wrench

Removal of stock seat:

Remove the rear 8mm
Allen screw with a 6mm
Allen wrench. This will be
used to mount your new
Mustang seat.



- 2. Slide the passenger seat back to remove.
- 3. Remove the 6mm bolts, and remove the bracket and handstrap.
- 4. Remove the 6mm front solo bolts, then lift the solo straight up and off the frame.

Installation of Mustang seat:

- Install the stud bracket to the fender using the stock 6mm fender bolts. The stud must be toward the back of the motorcycle.
- 2. Position the solo onto the frame. Place the nylon washer over the stud, lower the rear solo bracket over the stud, and <u>very loosely</u> engage the slotted nut.
- 3. Align the side brackets with the frame mount and secure with stock 6mm bolts.
- 4. Secure the nut on the fender bracket with a 5/8" wrench. **Do not overtighten.**
- 5. Engage the passenger seat's slotted front bracket with the slotted nut.
- 6. Secure the rear bracket with the stock 8mm screw, and check all mounts are secure.

Enjoy the comfort and custom look of your new Mustang seat!
